



**Archery England (EAF)**  
**Agreement between Tournament Organiser and Archery England (EAF)**

<b>Agreement Stipulations</b> <b>Target / Field / Clout / Longbow</b>	<b>Confirmed / Comment</b>
<b>Agreement:</b> The agreement to host the tournament shall be between Archery England and the appointed club of which the organiser is a member.	
<b>Venue:</b> The venue as agreed between both parties shall only be changed in extenuating circumstances which will be advised by the organiser.	
<b>Date:</b> Any changes to the tournament prospectus will be communicated to the Archery England Liaison. The tournament, once started, is abandoned, awards shall be given in accordance with the Archery GB (AGB) Rules of Shooting.	
<b>Round:</b> For Head 2 Head events any changes to the original prospectus must be communicated to Archery England	
<b>Archery England Head to Head Series</b> shall be open to all archers.	
<b>Record Status:</b> Application for Record Status will be the responsibility of the host Tournament Organiser (TO) in accordance with requirements of the event in which the Archery England category is held. The Fee will be reimbursed by Archery England	
<b>Entry Fee:</b> The entry fee for the tournament shall be determined by the organisers. Archery England shall not be liable for any reimbursement other than as detailed in this document. All entry fees and other income shall be retained by the organisers.	
<b>Advertisement / Entry Forms:</b> The detailed prospectus of the event is the responsibility of the Event Organiser which will include the Archery England logo and detail of awards. Links will be established between the event hosts and the Archery England web-site.	
<b>Medals:</b> Archery England Medals may be engraved. Medal allocation in accordance with entries and will be at the discretion of Archery England having taken the advice of the Organiser.	
<b>Assistance:</b> Archery England and the host club shall each appoint a named point of liaison who will be available as required between both parties.	
<b>Archery England Executive</b> member/s and or a designated officer will wherever possible, be in attendance at the event, and may only at the request of the organiser be involved in the prize giving.	
<b>Logo:</b> The Archery England logo will be used on entry forms and other promotional material. Where possible the Archery England 'Feathers' will be displayed.	
<b>Title:</b> When the tournament is run under the umbrella of another event the title of the tournament shall contain the legend "Incorporating Archery England"	
<b>Results:</b> will be made available via electronic means with links to Archery England website within one week of the tournament.	
<b>Officials:</b> The appointment of the Event Judges will be responsibility of the host T.O. Copies of judges and other reports may be requested by Archery England
