ARCHERY ENGLAND AND COMMONWEALTH ELIGIBILITY

Archers <u>must</u> meet the general eligibility criteria for Archery England <u>and</u> qualify to shoot for England under Commonwealth eligibility rules.

Eligibility Criteria for Archery England

- 1. The athlete must be affiliated to an English Member Region of the Federation
- 2. One or more of the following must apply:
 - a. Born in England
 - b. Have at least one parent born in England
 - c. Have at least one grandparent born in England
 - d. Been a continuous resident in England for at least a year (this refers to the 12 month period immediately preceding final entry deadline for the event)
- 3. The athlete must comply with World Archery Rule Book 1 Eligibility Code for Athletes and Team Officials Rule 2.4.2 (<u>https://worldarchery.sport/rulebook/article/7</u>)
