

Archery England (EAF) Agreement between Championship Organiser and Archery England (EAF)



Agreement Stipulations	Confirmed / Comment
Target / Field / Clout / Longbow	
Agreement : The agreement to host an Archery England (EAF) Championships shall be between Archery England and the appointed club of which the event organiser is a member	
Venue: The venue as agreed between both parties shall not be changed except Archery England being notified. The venue must comply with AGB / GNAS rules of shotting.	
Date: The date shall not be changed, nor the tournament cancelled, except with Archery England being consulted. If the tournament, once started, is abandoned, awards shall be given in accordance with the Archery GB / GNAS Rules of Shooting.	
Round: The round shall be as detailed in the initial agreement, any changes to the format must be notified to Archery England	
Record Status: Application for Record Status will be the responsibility of the host Tournament Organiser (TO) in accordance with requirements of the event in which an Archery England category is held. The Fee will be reimbursed by Archery England.	
Entry Fee: The entry fee for the tournament shall be determined by the organisers. Archery England shall not be liable for any reimbursement other than as detailed in this document. All entry fees and other income shall be retained by the organisers.	
Advertisement / Entry Forms: The detailed entry form is the responsibility of the organiser which will include the logo and detail of awards for those archers from the English Regions. The entry form will be available on the e Archery England Web-site and circulated to members.	
Trophies: Trophies if available for Archery England sections shall be provided by Archery England before the tournament. Archery England shall be responsible for contacting trophy holders to remind them to have the trophy engraved and returned to the appropriate tournament even if the holder does not intend to compete at the event. The organisers shall arrange for trophy winners to sign, with appropriate contact details for the trophies on the Archery England Record Sheet. Trophies that have not been awarded shall be returned to Archery England within one month.	
Medals: Medals for Archery England sections shall be provided by the Archery England Medals may be engraved. Medal allocation will be at the discretion of Archery England No archer can hold a championship medal if s/he has also competed or intends to compete in a standalone Archery England Championships i.e Longbow.	
Assistance: Archery England and the host club shall each appoint a named point of liaison between the Championships and Archery England If requested assistance will be provided for scoring and prize giving on the day.	
Archery England Executive member/s and or a designated officer will wherever possible, be in attendance at the Championships and may only at

the request of the organiser be involved in the prize giving.	
Logo: The Archery England logo will be used on entry forms and other promotional material.	
Title: When the tournament is run under the umbrella of another event the title of the tournament shall contain the legend "Incorporating The Archery England Championships.	
Results : These shall be made available to Archery England within one week of the tournament.	
Officials: The appointment of the Event Judges will be responsibility of the host organiser. Copies of judges and other reports may be requested by Archery England
