Archery England Commonwealth Championships Advisory 2021

Due to restrictions placed on shooting during the COVID-19 pandemic, selection criteria have been modified so that archers who were unable to compete at WRS events in 2020 and archers who met international selection criteria in 2019 are not disadvantaged.

All of the information in this document is subject to change as further details of the event emerge and the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic is better understood.

COMMONWEALTH ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIPS - SELECTION

A two level selection system will be in operation.

Level 1 selection criteria

Scores from 4th May 2019 to 15th Sept 2021

Recurve – WRS WA720

RM: 1 x ≥ 678 , or 2 x ≥ 673 , or 3 x ≥ 659 (must include 1 x 673)

RW: 1 x ≥ 663 , or 2 x ≥ 655 , or 3 x ≥ 637 (must include 1 x 655)

Compound – WRS 2 x WA720 & 4 x H2H

CM: 1996 (based on 2 x 702 and 4 x 148)

CW: 1960 (based on 2 x 690 and 4 x 145)

Important: Athletes who achieved Level 1 scores in 2019 or 2020 will receive a *provisional* Level 1 placing. To confirm this placing, they must achieve at least one Level 2 WA720 score (see below) from 2021, up to 15th Sept 2021.

If ≤ 3 archers achieve Level 1, they will automatically be selected for the Commonwealth team.

If > 3 archers achieve Level 1, a selection shoot will be carried out to determine the team and reserve places.

Any remaining places will be selected from Level 2.

Level 2 selection criteria

Scores from 2021 only, up 15th Sept 2021

Recurve – WA720

RM: 1 x ≥ 673 , or 2 x ≥ 659 , or 3 x ≥ 650

RW: 1 x ≥ 655 , or 2 x ≥ 637 , or 3 x ≥ 630

Compound – WA720 & H2H

CM: 1980 (based on 2 x 696 and 4 x 147)

CW: 1952 (based on 2 x 686 and 4 x 145)

If there are any team or reserve places remaining in a category when Level 1 scores are taken into account, a selection shoot to fill these places will take place including all Level 2 archers.



Any selection shoots will be held on **2nd/3rd Oct 2021 (TBC)**

Further government guidance-based restrictions on travel and organised sport will be taken into account during the selection process.

The above guidance is an advisory and is subject to change. Final selection criteria will be published on the Archery England website (www.archeryengland.org) as soon as the details have been ratified by the Archery England Executive Committee. The Committee reserves the right to amend the final criteria in exceptional circumstances. If too few archers meet the criteria for selection, the Committee will decide how many Team England archers will participate.

COMMONWEALTH ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIPS - ELIGIBILITY

Archers **must** meet the general eligibility criteria for Archery England **and** qualify to shoot for England under Commonwealth eligibility rules.

Eligibility Criteria for Archery England

1. The athlete must be affiliated to an English Member Region of the Federation
2. *One or more* of the following must apply:
 - a. Born in England
 - b. Have at least one parent born in England
 - c. Have at least one grandparent born in England
 - d. Been a continuous resident in England for at least a year (this refers to the 12 month period immediately preceding final entry deadline for the event)
3. The athlete must comply with World Archery Rule Book 1 - Eligibility Code for Athletes and Team Officials – Rule 2.4.2 (<https://worldarchery.sport/rulebook/article/7>)

Commonwealth eligibility rules
