

ARCHERY ENGLAND

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR SENIOR ARCHERS

May 2021

General Criteria:

1. The minimum age for selection to a senior team is 18 at the time of the event for which a score submission is made.
2. Score submissions will only be accepted if received by 6 pm on the cut-off date on the appropriate form and must be typed. A computer-generated signature is acceptable.
3. All submissions must be in Word or PDF format and made on the prescribed form available on the web site and sent to:
teamselection@archeryengland.org

All submissions will be acknowledged.

4. All scores **must** be from UK or WA Record Status events and may be from “closed” events such as the UK Masters or an international event where the archer is **NOT** representing GB.

Scores for submission must have been achieved in the period from the previous year’s cut -off date through to the published cut-off date in the current year: where practical submissions should include score(s) from the current season. This is at the discretion of Archery England.

5. Score submissions for the Outdoor and Indoor Home Nations tournaments are open to all qualified English Archers who are affiliated to an English Region, will be a minimum age of 18 at the time of the event and have not represented GB as a senior team member either indoors or outdoors in the 12 months prior to the event for which scores are submitted

Any archer who submits scores for an event and is then called upon to represent GB as an official GB team member, must immediately inform the Team Selector at email address at 3 above.

Event Specific Criteria:

1. **Senior Home Nations Outdoor Tournament**
(Incorporated into the British Target Championships)

Three scores from WA 1440 events (Record status)

Team members will be required to shoot on both days of the weekend

2. **Commonwealth Archery Championships of Europe (CACE)**

(held in different Commonwealth countries on a rotational basis or as agreed)

Three scores from WA 720 events (Record status)

English archers who are affiliated to an English Region and have represented GB in the 12 months prior to this event are permitted to submit scores provided they meet the eligibility rules of **Article 17 of the Commonwealth Games Federation Constitution** (see below).

3. **Senior Indoor Home Nations Tournament**

(Incorporated into the Senior National Indoor Championships, December)

Three scores from WA 18 metre events (Record status)

- A WA18 score as part of a combined WA18/Wa25 round is acceptable
- Scores from consecutive WA18 rounds shot on the same day are also acceptable

Team Places:

Offers of a place on the team will be made by the Team Selection Coordinator (TSC), with a standard letter requesting a response by return.

The TSC will pass details of team members to the Team Managers.

Until all acceptances have been received there will be an embargo on publication

Once all places have been accepted, those who have not been successful will be contacted by the TSC thanking them for their submission.

The ranking list, with team members marked, along with the non-travelling reserves, will be sent to Regional Representatives and the webmaster for publication.

Details will include: Name, Club, County and Region.

The above criteria will be reviewed annually at the Archery England November Committee Meeting.
