- It is open to All Archery England Affiliated Members.
- Most if not all this information is in the summary of the google forms so, please take the time to familiarise yourself with it.
- The qualifying Rounds are record status 720s for Compound, Recurve, Barebow & Longbow.
- Junior can take part but must shoot the senior Round.
- If there is interest a junior ranking can be produced, depending on numbers.
- If you don't see an archer's name, they may not have registered.
- All submissions and registration information are linked to a spreadsheet and the calculations within the document are uniform.
- I don't manually input the data or adjust it as the data is pulled from the google form into my spreadsheet.

#### Rankings – How are they calculated.

- The Minimum number of scores is 5.
- The Rankings scores are calculated on the Average of your top 5 submissions. (Divided by 5)
- If you have not submitted 5 scores 0 will be used in place of the missing scores.

Example 1 & 2 are used in the production of the rankings.

#### • Example 1 – Used in the Rankings

The Minimum of 5 scores are submitted. Average taken from that if more than 5 are submitted the Top 5 will be used.

#### • Example 2 – Used in the Rankings

Only 3 scores have been submitted, to enable a fair average score to be calculated zeros are added. As new submission come in the zeros will be replaced with actuals. The average score being calculated using the zeros.

This enables people to take part even if they have not completed 5 scores and for me to divide the score by 5.

#### • Example 3 – NOT USED in the Rankings

Only 3 scores have been submitted and calculating the average score from the 3 submitted scores would be unfair as it would be potentially higher, giving a false ranking average.

Also, the rankings are base from the average of your 5 scores not 3, and I would not be able to divide the scores by 5, obviously.
